



Fête Community Standards

At Fête, we're building a platform for people to adventure, experience, and interact. We want to ensure everyone feels welcome and safe and is treated with kindness and respect. That's why we've created these Community Standards: to outline how we expect our users to behave, and to be clear up front about what is and isn't allowed on Fête, on Fête's Platform, social media accounts, at events using Fête, or any and all other related activities or digital spaces that include Fête.

Our Community Standards are organized into four sections:

- Safety
- Civility & Respect
- Fairness & Transparency
- Security & Privacy

These standards apply to all of your actions on Fête and with other Users, both online and at real-world events hosted by Hosts. We ask that you respect our standards — and understand that violating them may result in enforcement action against your account. We're always learning, so as our community evolves and our platform grows, these standards may change too.

In short, when using Fête, always remember to be kind. If you see something that you think violates the Community Standards, please let us know. We appreciate your cooperation with these standards and commitment to making Fête a safe and respectful space.

SAFETY

We want our platform to be safe and welcoming for everyone, regardless of their identity or beliefs. To keep Fête a place where everyone feels comfortable being themselves, the following is not allowed:

1. Real World Physically Dangerous Activities

Fête does not allow the depiction, glorification, or encouragement of participation in activities in the real world that are specifically designed to create a risk of physical harm to the participant offline.

2. Threats of Violence

Fête does not permit users to threaten others with real world harm or to encourage such threats, or to incite violence against people or property, and we may communicate with law enforcement agencies regarding credible threats of harm.

3. Bullying and Harassment

Fête does not allow bullying, stalking, trolling, harassment, or intimidation on its platform. We also do not allow any content that depicts, glorifies, or promotes such behavior.

4. Sexual Content or Child Endangerment

Fête does not allow sexual content or activity of any kind. Fête has a zero-tolerance policy for endangering children. This includes any predatory behavior aimed at minors.

5. Violent Content

We don't allow content that contains violence or physical or psychological abuse.

CIVILITY AND RESPECT

We expect all Users to treat one another with kindness. This means striving to be civil and respectful in all of your interactions. To encourage this environment, Fête prohibits:

1. Discrimination, Slurs, and Hate Speech

Fête honors and welcomes users of all ages, backgrounds, and identities. You may not demean, threaten, or attack individuals or groups, or encourage others to do so directly or indirectly, on the basis of their race, perceived race, or ethnicity; National origin; Sexual orientation; Gender, gender identity, or gender expression; Religion or religious affiliation or beliefs; Age; Physical or mental disability; Veteran status; Familial status; any other status.

2. Profanity

To keep Fête safe and civil for everyone, we don't allow swearing in text, images, or uploaded audio.

3. Harmful Off-Platform Speech and Behavior

Users treat everyone with respect, both on and off of Fête. If reported to us, we may disable the accounts of users who harass, bully, discriminate, or harm others outside of Fête, or share others' personal information off-platform.

4. Abuse of Fête Employees or Affiliates

Fête expects its users to treat all Fête employees, contractors, or affiliates with kindness and respect. Mistreating Fête employees, contractors, or their families in any form, including via email, off-platform, or in-person could result in the loss of your account.

FAIRNESS AND TRANSPARENCY

Fête aims to build a community that's transparent about its rules and how they're enforced. We want Users to trust each other to play fairly and honestly, and to respect one another's creativity and hard work. To help build such a community, Fête requires its users to follow their local laws and does not allow:

1. Scams

We don't permit deceptive schemes on our platform, including: Sending or posting phishing or scamming links; Requesting passwords or access to another user's account; Selling or seeking to buy accounts; Uploading unauthorized copies of content; or Selling Fête assets for real money off-platform.

2. Spam

Fête prohibits content that is designed to deceive others or that is shared repeatedly and disruptively anywhere on the platform.

3. Cheating and Exploits

Although some parts of Experiences may include Players "fooling" or "cheating" other Players within the Experience, we don't permit users to deploy or discuss any methods of real-life cheating, in any form whatsoever, or of exploiting the Platform's software to gain any unfair advantage.

4. Intellectual Property Violations

We don't allow users to violate intellectual property rights on Fête, and will remove infringing content upon receiving a valid Digital Millennium Copyright Act (DMCA) notice or Trademark infringement removal request. Examples of intellectual property infringement may include using a brand's logo or designs for the content you design without their permission.

5. Advertising

You can place ads in the form of Virtual Items as long as you follow the rules outlined below. Fête will determine, at its sole discretion, whether advertising or brand placement meets these requirements and we may reject ads whose content harms our relationship with our community or compromises our competitive interests. If your ad violates these rules, we may remove the content or suspend your experience, or require you to remove the content, at any time and without notice.

- Users who place advertisements remain responsible for all advertising content; ads must follow the Community Rules, the Terms of Use and all other Fête rules.
- Ads may not contain content intended for users under the age of 13.

- Ads must comply with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act ("COPPA"), Children's Advertising Review Unit ("CARU") and Children's Food and Beverage Advertising Initiative ("CFBAI") guidelines, and all other applicable local laws and regulations.
- Ads cannot include false, deceptive, misleading, or inappropriate content, each as determined by Fête in its sole discretion.

SECURITY AND PRIVACY

For our community to thrive, the Fête community must feel digitally safe as well as physically, mentally and emotionally safe. We can achieve this by respecting each other's private information and Fête's safety systems, and by keeping Fête accounts and systems secure. This section describes how Players and Hosts should treat others' information and digital security. To maintain a safe Platform, Fête does not permit:

1. Unauthorized Access

We prohibit any activity that is used to gain unauthorized access to Fête's systems or accounts, as well as threatening or encouraging such activity. This includes:

- Attempting to hack another user's account
- Launching any sort of cyberattack
- Posting misleading links for the purpose of gaining unauthorized access (i.e., phishing)
- Launching malicious software (i.e., malware) to cause damage to or gain access to another user's computer.

2. Sharing Personal Information

We do not permit users to share their or others' personal information on Fête.
